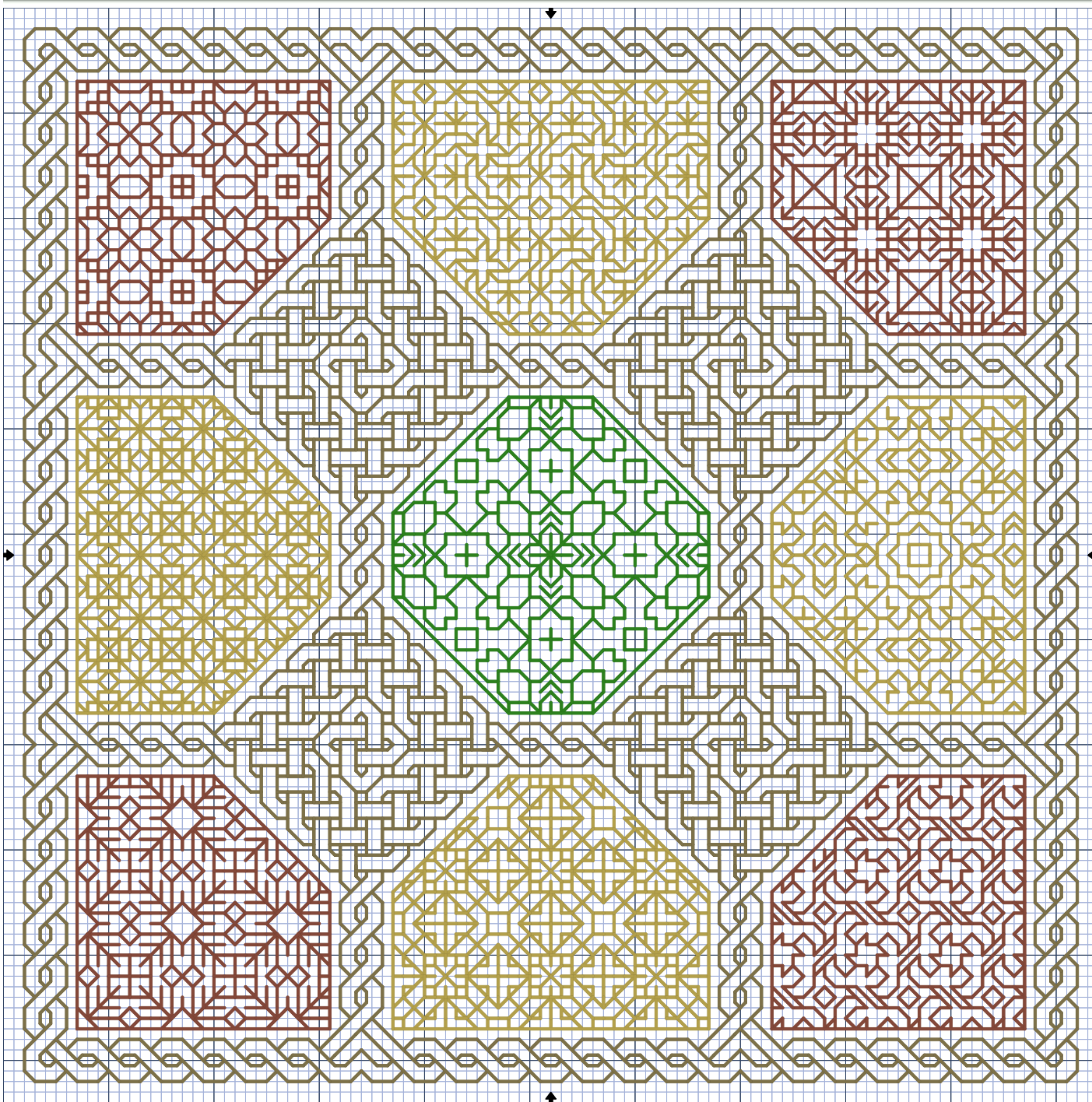

# BN-6004 WINDOWPANES IN KNOTWORK - STAINED GLASS



Blackwork is historically done in black thread. In today's world where we have the full range of colors, as well as the hand-dyed and variegated threads, there are countless possibilities for your project.  
 NOTE: This design will stitch up easier when using evenweave fabrics, due to the nature of the Knotwork designs. Each graph square represents 2 threads.

<b>Fabric</b>	Zweigart #3626/101 Jazlyn (28 count) - Color: Antique White
<b>Thread</b>	Gentle Arts Sampler Threads (1 5-yard Skein needed of each color)
<b>Back Stitch</b>	All stitching in 1 strand
<b>Credits</b>	Debbie Draper, Model Stitcher

- #190 Forest Glade (or DMC 936)
- #350 Mulberry (or DMC 221)
- #440 Maple Syrup (or DMC 3781)
- #460 Grecian Gold (or DMC 832)

## PROJECT SIZE

<b>Stitches</b>	100 Square
<b>14 Count</b>	7-1/8" Square
<b>16 Count</b>	6-1/4" Square
<b>18 Count</b>	5-1/2" Square
<b>22 Count</b>	4-1/2" Square
